(LEES LANE, DALTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lees Lane, Dalton, 160 metres from its junction with Long Heys or Back Lane for a distance of 165 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 to 1630 hours on Tuesday 24th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:Lees Lane, Appley Lane South, Appley Lane North, B5375 Appley Lane
 North, A5209 Hall Lane, A5209 Sparrow Hill, A5209 Parbold Hill, A5209 Alder
 Lane, Higher Lane, Lees Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rebuilding works of chamber to be carried out.
