(GRANGE LANE, HUTTON, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Grange Lane, Hutton from a point directly outside Woodfold Farm for a distance of 133 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Sunday 8th March 2026 until 1700 hours on Monday 9th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not applicable.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation clearance works around overhead electrical cables to be carried out.
