NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Clifford Street, Barnoldswick from Its junction with Rainhall Road to its junction with Rear 61 to 73 Rainhall Road.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Friday 19th December 2025 until 1700 hours on Thursday 8th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the repair to dangerous gable wall to property to be carried out.
