(PRIVATE ROAD, HOGHTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Private Road, Hoghton from its junction with Station Road, Hoghton for a distance of 174 metres in a southwest direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 2nd March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Private Road – Gregson Lane – Daub Hall Lane - A675 Hoghton Lane - A675 The Straits – Station Road and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable access for Engineers to work on underground structure to provide service to customer
