(BELMONT ROAD, PEEL STREET, RIVINGTON AVENUE, MAYFIELD AVENUE,
ADLINGTON, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Belmont Road, Adlington from its junction with Peel Street, Adlington for its entire length.
 - II. Peel Street, Adlington from its junction with B6227 Railway Road, Adlington for its entire length.
 - III. Rivington Avenue, Adlington from its junction with B6227 Railway Road, Adlington for its entire length.
 - IV. Mayfield Avenue, Adlington from its junction with B6227 Railway Road, Adlington for its entire length.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Thursday 22nd January 2026 until Friday 23rd January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
