

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LITTLE STREET, ACCRINGTON HYNDBURN BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. i. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Little Street Accrington from its junction with Blackburn Road for a distance of 25 metres in a southerly direction.
ii. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Willows Lane Accrington from its junction with Blackburn Road for a distance of 50 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from hours on Tuesday 6th January 2026 until 2359 hours on Friday 9th January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate precision cutting in carriageway works to be carried out on behalf of Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
