

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
**(PEDDER STREET, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY) (REVOCATION,
GOODS VEHICLE LOADING AND LIMITED WAITING) ORDER 202***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Lancaster City Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to Item (12)(ii) of Schedule 12.066.
2. Introduce a goods vehicle loading bay in Pedder Street, Morecambe, the north east side, from a point 40.5 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Nelson Street for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction.
3. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 1 hour with no return within 1 hour, Monday to Saturday 8am – 6pm in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Pedder Street, Morecambe, the north side, from a point 5 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Nelson Street for a distance of 35.5 metres in an easterly direction;
 - b) Pedder Street, Morecambe, the north east side, from a point 10.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Marine Road Central for a distance of 26.5 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - c) Pedder Street, Morecambe, the north west side, from a point 2 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Back Crescent Street for a distance of 23 metres in an easterly direction.
