

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MARSDEN HALL ROAD AND REAR 171 TO 189 BARKERHOUSE ROAD,
NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. **Marsden Hall Road** from its junction with Barkerhouse Road to outside number 2 Marsden Hall Road.
 - ii. **Rear 171 to 189 Barkerhouse Road** from its junction with Gable End of 177 to 179 Barkerhouse Road to the gable end of number 2 Marsden Hall Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Monday 2nd February 2026 until 2359 hours on Sunday 15th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
 - i. **Marsden Hall Road**
Barkerhouse Road – Townhouse Road – Walton Lane and vice versa
 - ii. **Rear 171 to 189 Barkerhouse Road**
Barkerhouse Road – Gable End 177 to 179 Barkerhouse Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out.
