

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(CLARKE STREET, POUTON-LE-FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Clarke Street, Poulton-Le-Fylde from its junction with Aldon Road to its junction with Furness Drive.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 2000 hours on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026 until 0500 hours on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Furness Drive – Bracewell Avenue – Garstang Road East and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow remedial works to repair depression works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
