FYLDE BOROUGH) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Speed Limit Order under Section 84 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in the following lengths of road:

- a) Gilbert Way, Bryning with Warton, the entire length;
- b) Riversleigh Way, Bryning with Warton, the entire length.
