

# Know More, Remember More in EYFS

## Take it Outside!

Role-play learning and revisit over the year - for example story telling on the outdoor stage or singing favourite songs!

## Calm...

Ensure that the climate is calm for children to concentrate and remember more. Effective use of adults to engage in high quality interactions to support children.

## Make Connections.

Making connections between learning when appropriate strengthens children's memory.

## Remembering Rhino

Puppets used to encourage children to remember and recall previous learning.

## Actions

Actions help children to remember new "special words."

## Website or Dojo

Online resources used to engage parents with learning over time. For example, home learning tasks may be to remember previous stories in an online video.

# Know More, Remember More in EYFS

## Sing, Sing, Sing!

Use songs to remember core facts, develop language, story phrases... drip feed throughout the day and revisit over the year!

## Repeat, Repeat!

Enhanced provision repeated throughout the year so children have repeated exposure over time to storytelling, rhymes, number etc ..

## Dual Coding

Children remember new knowledge when accompanied by simple pictures.

## The power of a picture

Beautiful and simple images or photographs are a powerful and simple way for children to remember previous learning and make connections.

## Stories

Stories mapped, planned for and within provision over the year to make connections with previous learning.

## FloorBooks

FloorBook used to display key images/photographs / children's work. Used as a remembering tool flexibly, personalised for each child.
