
(GUILDE LANE AND HADDINGS LANE, HIGHAM, PENDLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Guide Lane and Haddings Lane, Higham
  - i. Guide Lane, Higham from its junction with Haddings Lane for approximately 23 metres in southerly direction.
  - ii. Haddings Lane, Higham, from its junction with Guide Lane for approximately 41 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services will follow the diversion. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Croft Top – Noggarth Road – Wheatley Lane Road – St Annes Way – Barrowford Road – Higham Hall Road – Sabden Road – Back Lane – Stup Hall Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a new water connection to be carried out.
