(PENDLE ROAD, DOWNHAM, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Pendle Road, Downham from approximately 60 metres westerly from Hecklin Farm for approximately 20 metres in westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 00:00 hours on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2026 until 23:59 hours on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services whenever and wherever possible.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be displayed locally:

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the completion of urgent repair works to a water leak whilst maintaining customer supplies.
