(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Houghclough Lane, Chipping from its junction with Blacksticks Lane to its junction with Parsonage Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on 2nd March 2026 until 1630 hours on 3rd March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Parsonage Lane – Garstang Road – Collin's Hill Lane – Fiddler's Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Morrison Telecom Services to carry out pole maintenance works.
