(RAWCLIFFE ROAD, ST MICHAELS, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rawcliffe Road, St Michaels from outside Turnover Hall Farm to its junction with Paddington Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 on Monday 9th March 2026 until Tuesday 10th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Rawcliffe Road – Lancaster Road – Sandside – Marsh Lane – Main Street – Garstang Road – Park Lane – Nateby Crossing Lane – Garstang Bypass Road – The Avenue – Tarnacre Lane – Garstang Road – Rawcliffe Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow overhead cabling works to be carried out by BT.
