(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Kent Drive, Knuzden Oswaldtwistle from its junction with Windsor Road for a distance of 35 metres in an easterly direction and Windsor Road for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Saturday 4th April 2026 to 1700 hours on Sunday 12th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. No diversion is required due to a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow access to manhole works undertaken by MV Kelly.
