

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(NARROW MOSS LANE, SCARISBRICK,
WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Narrow Moss Lane, Scarisbrick from its junction with Moorfield Lane for a distance of 145 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 to 1530 hours on Monday 16th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Moorfield Lane, B5242 Barrison Green, B5242 Pippin Street, A59 High Lane, A59 County Road, Hayfield Road, Yew Tree Road, Grimshaw Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out.
