(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with A6 Preston Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - II. Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Four Oaks Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - III. Four Oaks Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with A6 Preston Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - IV. Bradkirk Place, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - V. Carnfield Place, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - VI. Cocker Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - VII. Newfield Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - VIII. Oldfield Road, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Newfield Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
 - IX. Leach Place, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge for its entire length.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2030 hours until 0500 hours on Monday 23rd February 2026 until Wednesday 25th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not applicable.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
