

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BOUNDARY LANE, HESKETH BANK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Boundary Lane, Hesketh Bank to a point 88 metres north of its junction with Boundary Meanygate for a distance of 200 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 16th March until 1600 hours on Friday 27th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Boundary Meanygate, Taylors Meanygate and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow installation work to be carried out for new ducting, footway boxes, a new duct tee and to clear duct blockages.
