(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2026


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any pedestrian to proceed over that length of The Ginnel, Leyland from its junction with Sandy Lane, Leyland for a distance of 35 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2026 until 1700 hours on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure is via:-

The Ginnel – Haydock Avenue – Liege Road – Eden Street - B5254 St Andrews Way - B5248 Church Road – Balcarres Road – Balcarres Place – Sandy Lane and Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation, and replacement works to be carried out.
