

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(LYNDHURST ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)

(REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF BUS STOP

CLEARWAY)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stop clearway in Lyndhurst Road, Burnley, the north side, from a point 5.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Celia Street for a distance of 41 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Lyndhurst Road, Burnley, the north side, from a point 3.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Lebanon Street for a distance of 17 metres in a westerly direction;
 - b) Lyndhurst Road, Burnley, the north side, from a point 3.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Admiral Street for a distance of 17 metres in a westerly direction;
 - c) Lyndhurst Road, Burnley, the south side, from a point 5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Lebanon Street for a distance of 19 metres in a westerly direction;
 - d) Lyndhurst Road, Burnley, the south side, from a point 3.5 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Linden Street for a distance of 17 metres in an easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to provide Bus Stop Clearways (signs and markings only) to the existing bus stops to allow the local buses to service these stops safely and effectively by preventing other vehicles parking at any time.

The proposal also includes the removal of an existing bus stop on the north side of Lyndhurst Road, with the stop to be relocated further east along the same road.
