(CHORLEY OLD ROAD, WHITTLE-LE-WOODS, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Chorley Old Road, Whittle Le Woods from its junction with Cow Well Lane, Whittle Le Woods for a distance of 28 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1440 hours on Saturday 31st January 2026 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 4th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow open cut excavation works to be carried out to replace leaking hydrant in the footway.
