

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STONEHOLME ROAD, CRAWSHAWBOOTH, ROSENDALE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Stoneholme Road, Crawshawbooth from its junction with Turton Hollow Road for approximately 60 Metres in a Northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 2nd March 2026 until 1700 hours on Monday 9th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Blackburn Road, Regent Street, Church Street, Lower Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to excavate joint bay in the footway works to be carried out by Network Plus.
