(REAR OF CECIL STREET, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FLYDE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear of Cecil Street, Lytham St Annes from its junction with School Lane to the outside the rear of 19 Cecil Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Wednesday 22nd April 2026 until 1600 hours on Thursday 23rd April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Upper Westby Street, Cecil Street, Church Road, Agnew Street, Upper Westby Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole replacement works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management on behalf of Morrison Telecom Services.
