
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of roads;

Road Closed	Length closed
Earl Street, Lancaster	From its junction with Albert Road to its junction with Derby Road.
Derby Road, Lancaster	From its junction with Earl Street to its junction with Albert Road.
Albert Road, Lancaster	From its Junction with Lune Street to its junction with Derby Road.
Back Elgin Street, Lancaster	From its junction with Albert Road to its junction with Lord Street.
Lord Street, Lancaster	From its junction with Lune Terrace to its junction with Lune Street
Lune Terrace, Lancaster	From its junction with Lord Street to its End
Lune Street, Lancaster	From its junction with A589 Greyhound Bridge Road to its junction with A589 Owen Road.

2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours from Monday 16th February 2026 until Wednesday 18th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. A diversion will be signed locally. The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
