(ALBERT STREET, WHITWORTH, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Albert Street, Whitworth from its junction of Market Street for 30 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -  
  
Market Street - Hall Street - Massey Croft - Albert Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to excavate joint bay to install and joint cable for Hall to Healey Capital Scheme.
