

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
RONALDSWAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ronaldsway, Preston from outside of number 64 to number 83 Ronaldsway, Preston.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 16th March 2026 until 1800 hours on Friday 20th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Cromwell Road – Watling Street Road – Sir Tom Finney Way – Primrose Road – Holme Slack Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to lay duct in the footway and carriageway to be carried out.
