(NATEBY CROSSING LANE, NATEBY, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Nateby Crossing Lane, Nateby from outside Nateby House Farm to outside Old Bridge House.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2026 until Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Croston Barn Lane - A6 Preston Lancaster New Road - Longmoor Lane  
& Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow fibre optic cabling and splicing works to be carried out by Morrisons Telecom Services.
