(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Belmont Road, Rivington from its junction with Sheep House Lane, Rivington for its entire length.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Wednesday 4th February 2026 until 1630 hours on Tuesday 24th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;

The temporary prohibition is necessary to prevent danger to the public arising.
