

## **NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(LOWER LANE AND LOWER ROAD, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE  
VALLEY BOROUGH) (REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF  
BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)**



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove a bus stop clearway in Lower Lane, Longridge, the north side, from a point 64 metres east of the centreline of Hollin Hall Drive for a distance of 19 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Lower Road, Longridge, the north side, from a point 197 metres west of its centreline junction with Ribchester Road for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction;
  - b) Lower Road, Longridge, the south side, from a point 68 metres south west of its centreline junction with Ribchester Road for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction.

### **Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this proposal is to upgrade the existing bus stop on Lower Road Longridge, with enforceable clearway markings and signs allowing buses to pull in safely and efficiently at the stop and introduce a new bus stop clearway.

The proposal intends to promote sustainable transport for all users by including the construction of a raised platform, allowing safe boarding and alighting of passengers.

The proposals include the repositioning of the existing bus stop to a more appropriate location to take into consideration the new vehicular access for the industrial development.

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new industrial development.
