(NABS HEAD LANE, SPRING LANE, SAMLESBURY, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Nabs Head Lane, Samlesbury from its junction with A677 Preston New Road, Mellor Brook to its junction with Spring Lane, Samlesbury.
 - II. Spring Lane, Samlesbury from its junction with Nabs Head Lane, Samlesbury to its junction with Further Lane, Samlesbury.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 20th July 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 14th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Nabs Head Lane - A677 Preston New Road – Further Lane – Spring Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to replace existing water main with new main as part of the United Utilities mains replacement program.
