
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Chapel Lane, Galgate for a distance of approximately 10 metres either side of property known as Silk Mill Cottage.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026 until 1600 hours on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure are via:-
  - a) Chapel Lane – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – Hazelrigg Lane – Chapel Lane.
  - b) Chapel Lane – Hazerigg Lane – A6 Preston Lancaster Road – Tanhouse Road – Chapel Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Installation of one short sided 32-millimetre connection to the 32-millimetre water main to be carried out.
