
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Abbeystead Lane, Dolphinholme from its junction with Anyon Lane to outside property no.1 Anyon Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 24th February 2026 until 1800 hours on Thursday 26th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for Emergency Services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Four Lane Ends – Anyon Lane – Chipping Road – Bay Horse Road
– Quernmore Brow – Rakehouse Brow – Long Lane – Abbeystead Road – Gleaves Hill Lane – Four Lane Ends and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to repair consequential damage to be carried out.
