(OAKLAND STREET AND CHAPEL STREET, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of
 - i. Oakland Street, Nelson from its junction with Chapel Street to its junction with Rear 50-60 Chapel Street.
 - ii. Chapel Street, Nelson from its junction with Victory Close to outside number 50 Chapel Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1430 hours on Tuesday 10th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Chapel Street – Arthur Street – Leeds Road – Holme Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cabling and jointing works to be carried out.
