(B5312 GRIMSHAW ROAD, SKELMERSDALE, WEST LANCASHIRE
BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway:
 - i. B5321 Grimshaw Road, Skelmersdale slip road only (Eastbound carriageway) from its junction with Tanhouse Road for a distance of 200 metres in an easterly direction.
 - ii. B5312 Grimshaw Road, Skelmersdale slip road only (Westbound carriageway) from its junction with Tanhouse Road for a distance of 310 metres in a westerly direction
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 to 1530 hours on Tuesday 10th March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Due to the nature of the works, there will be no access for emergency services.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
B5312 Grimshaw Road (Eastbound), A577 Stannanought Road
(Windmill roundabout), B5312 Grimshaw Road (Westbound)

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telephone mast replacement works to be carried out.
