

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(HOUGH LANE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hough Lane, Leyland (eastbound carriageway only) from its junction with Dorothy Avenue, Leyland to its junction with B5254 Churchill Way.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Hough Lane – School Lane - B5256 Golden Hill Lane - B5254 Churchill Way and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation works to be carried out to reset frame and cover in the carriageway.
