
(BRIERLEY ROAD, FOUR OAKS ROAD, TRAMWAY LANE AND WALTON SUMMIT ROAD, BAMBER BRIDGE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge to its junction with Four Oaks Road, Bamber Bridge.
 - II. Walton Summit Road, Bamber Bridge from a point 5 metres either side of its junction with Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge.
 - III. Four Oaks Road, Bamber Bridge from a point 5 metres either side of its junction with Brierley Road, Bamber Bridge.
 - IV. Tramway Lane, Bamber Bridge from its junction with Four Oaks Road, Bamber Bridge for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 2030 hours until 0500 hours on Sunday 12th April 2026 until Friday 17th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not applicable.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway re-surfacing works to be carried out.
