

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(MOORGATE AREA, ORMSKIRK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)**  
**(PART REVOCATION PROHIBITION OF WAITING, RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND**  
**RESIDENTS PERMIT HOLDERS PARKING PLACES)**  
**ORDER 2012**

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

**1. Definitions and Interpretation**

For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:

- a) "**the Council's duly authorised officer**" means a person appointed by the Council or its local agent, or authority to administer the powers conferred on the said Council by the 1984 Act with respect to this and other Traffic Regulations.
- b) "**disabled person's badge**" means a badge which was –
  - i) issued, or has effect as if issued, to a disabled person or an institution under The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations or under regulations having effect in Scotland or Wales under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970; and
  - ii) has not ceased to be in force.
- c) "**disabled person's vehicle**" means a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the circumstances prescribed in Regulations 13, 14, 15 or 16 of The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.
- d) "**parking disc**" means a device which -
  - i) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue, if issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2000, or orange if issued before that date;
  - ii) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
  - iii) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun.
- e) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the "**relevant position**" if -
  - i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or
  - ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.
- f) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the "**relevant position**" if -

- i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
  - ii) where the vehicle does not have a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.
- g) **"permit holder"** means a person to whom a permit has been issued (For the purpose of this Order a Doctor on call is deemed to be a Permit Holder but is not required to display a Permit);
- h) **"Residents Parking Place"** means any area of highway referred to in schedule 6 to this Order;
- i) **"vehicle"** means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motorcycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power;
- j) **"Civil Enforcement Officer"** means a person authorised by or on behalf of Lancashire County Council in accordance with Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;
- k) **"residents parking permit"** means a Residents Parking Permit issued by the Council or its local agent or authority. Charges and terms for said Permit are published by the issuing authority. Schedule 7 to this order gives further details regarding properties eligible for a residents parking permit.

## 2. Revocations

Those parts of the Order specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, are hereby revoked.

## 3. Prohibition of Waiting

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

## 4. Restriction of Waiting

- a) Save as in hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 08:00 and 18:00, Monday until Saturday inclusively, in any of the lengths of road specified in schedule 3 to this order.
- b) Save as in hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for a period exceeding 30 minutes, no return within 2 hours, between 08:00 and 18:00 from Monday to Saturday inclusively, in any of the lengths of road as specified in schedule 4 to this order.
- c) Save as in hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait for a period exceeding 2 hours, no return within 2 hours, at any time, on any day, in any of the lengths of road as specified in schedule 5 to this order.

## **5. Exemption for Resident Permit Holders**

Nothing in Article 4c) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parking places referred to therein, if the vehicle is a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid Zone A Residents Parking Permit.

## **6. Residents Parking Places**

Save as is hereinafter provided no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, at any time, on any day, in the permit holders parking places along the following lengths of road as specified in schedule 6 to this order, unless a holder of a valid Residents Parking Permit in respect of the Parking Place in which the vehicle has been left and he displays such permit on that vehicle in accordance with Article 10 of this Order.

## **7. General Exemptions**

Nothing in Articles 3, 4 or 6 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- b) goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following:-
  - i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
  - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads;
  - iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus or the exercise of any other statutory power or duty for the maintenance and supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- d) the vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;
- e) a Royal Mail liveried vehicle to be used for delivering or collecting postal packets in accordance with the statutory provisions as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
- f) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- g) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road for so long as such waiting by the vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral.

**8. Exemptions for disabled person's vehicles**

- a) Nothing in Articles 4b or 4c of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to therein if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc marked to show the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began.
- b) Nothing in Articles 3 or 4a of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to therein for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day) if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc marked to show the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began.

**9. Additional Exemptions**

Nothing in Article 3, 4 or 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait, in the length of road referred to therein When the person in control of the vehicle

- i. is required by law to stop;
- ii. is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or
- iii. is prevented from proceeding along the road due to circumstances beyond his/her control;

**10. Display of Parking Permit**

A Residents Parking Permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall be displayed in the vehicle in respect of which the Residents Parking Permit has been issued in a conspicuous position so that the date and time of issue are clearly visible to a person standing at the front or kerbside of such vehicle for the whole of the time during which the vehicle is left.

**11. Manner of standing in a Parking Place**

- a) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in a position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or, or depart from, the parking place.
- b) Every vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be left so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.
- c) A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining a road or the use of a road by other persons or so as to be a nuisance.

**12. Alteration of position of a vehicle in a Parking Place**

Where any vehicle is left standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 11 of this Order, a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

**13. Removal of a Vehicle from a Parking Place**

Where a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Article 11 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he/she may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the said parking place, and where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the said vehicle.

**14. Movement of a Vehicle in a Parking Place in an Emergency**

- a) A police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may in case of emergency move or cause to be moved any vehicle left in a Parking Place to any place he thinks fit and shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- b) A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a Parking Place by virtue of the provisions of paragraph a) of this Article shall take all such steps as are necessary to ensure that in the case of a Parking Place it shall stand in accordance with Article 11 so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the Parking Place.

**15. Power to suspend use of Parking Places**

- a) The Council's duly authorised officer may suspend the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof whenever he/she considers such suspensions reasonably necessary and make such charge for the administration of this service, as may from time to time be determined by the Council.
- b) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than 7 days the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof whenever he/she considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of mitigating congestion or obstruction of traffic or a danger to or from traffic in consequence of extraordinary circumstances.
- c) Any persons suspending the use of a Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph a) or b) of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that Parking Place the use of which is suspended, a Traffic Sign or cone indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited, as specified by Schedule 12 Part II of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- d) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a Parking Place during such period when a Traffic Sign or cone is placed in or adjacent to that part of the Parking Place pursuant to paragraph c) of this Article provided that this paragraph shall not apply to a vehicle:
  - i) being used by the respective Fire or Police Authority or Ambulance Health Trust to deal with an emergency; or
  - ii) being used for any purpose specified in Article 9; or
  - iii) left in such Parking Place with the permission of the person suspending the use of the Parking Place.

**16. Restriction of use of a vehicle in a parking place**

While any vehicle is in a disabled parking place no person shall use the said vehicle in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the disabled parking place or in connection with the selling of or offering for sale of his/her skills or services.

**17. Miscellaneous**

The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

## 18. Commencement of Order



### SCHEDULE 1

Part Revocation

**Revoke** those parts of the "Lancashire County Council (West Lancashire District Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to the following restrictions in West Lancashire:

#### Waiting Prohibited At Any Time:

Schedule 10.01

Item No (28) Bridge Avenue, Ormskirk a) the east side from its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 44 metres or thereabouts in a north-easterly direction;  
b) the west side from its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 5 metres or thereabouts in a north-easterly direction.

Item No (29) Bridge Street, Ormskirk, a) both sides from its junction with Chapel Street for a distance of 20 metres in a south-westerly direction:  
(b) the north side (i) from a point 93 metres north-west of the centre line of Ravenscroft Avenue for a distance of 52.5 metres in a north-westerly direction;  
(ii) From Aughton Street to the rear footway line on the west side of Moorgate;  
c) the northern side from a point 5 metres south-east of the centre line of Ravenscroft Avenue for a distance of 41 metres in a south-easterly direction and then north-easterly direction;  
d) the south side (i) from a point 133 metres north-west of the centre line of Ravenscroft Avenue, for a distance of 22.5 metres in a north-westerly direction;  
(ii) from a point 17 metres north-west of the centre line of Moorgate for a distance of 12 metres in a north westerly direction;  
(iii) from a point 20 metres north-west of the centre line of Ravenscroft Avenue for a distance of 40 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Item No (37) Chapel Street, Ormskirk, b) the west side (iii) from its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

Item No (65) Dyers Lane, Ormskirk a) the north side from its junction with Moorgate in an easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres:

c) the south side (i) from its junction with Ryburn Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres;

(ii) for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction from its junction with Ryburn Road.

Item No (124) Moorgate, Ormskirk a) the east side (iii) from its junction with Bridge Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 65 metres:

b) the south-east side (iii) from a point 60 metres south-west of the centre line of Queen Street in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 20 metres;

d) the west side (i) from its junction with Queen Street for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction;

(ii) from its junction with Queen Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 145 metres to its junction with Dyers Lane.

Item No (148) Queen Street a) both sides for a distance of 27 metres from the easterly kerb line of Aughton Street:

b) the north side from its junction with Moorgate for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction;

c) the south side (i) from a point 27 metres south of its junction with Aughton Street in a south – easterly direction to its junction with Moorgate, a distance of 133 metres;

Item No (176) South Terrace, Ormskirk a) the northerly side from a point 20 metres south-west of the centre line of Queen Street for a distance of 55 metres in a south-westerly then north-westerly direction

b) the south-west side for a distance of 40 metres or thereabouts in a south-westerly and then north-westerly direction from a point 30 metres south-west of its junction with Queen Street

4. Moorgate, Ormskirk, the south-east side from a point 81.5 metres south west of the centre line of Queen Street for a distance of 47 metres in a south-westerly direction
5. South Terrace Ormskirk, the east & south side from point 14 metres of the centre line of Queen Street for a distance of 14 metres in a south-westerly direction.


