Concerns were raised by West Lancashire Borough Council regarding access issues for their refuge vehicles due to parked vehicles on Elm Place and the surrounding roads.

In response to the concerns, officers carried out site visits on different days and at different times of the day which confirmed the reported concerns. On all the site visits vehicles were observed parking on the bends and limiting the road width.

To address the issue, officers propose to introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions to remove obstructive parking and assist in the general movement of traffic.

The proposal also seeks to amend the Traffic Regulation Order to match the existing road markings on site at Brook Lane, allowing for effective enforcement.

Following a request, it is proposed to include property No 137 Burscough Street in the permit allocation schedule and extend the length of the existing parking bay.

The proposed amendment to the restrictions on Scarisbrick Street is considered appropriate to provide parking capacity for all eligible properties within the extent of the scheme.
