

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MANCHESTER ROAD AREA, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(ROAD HUMPS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce road humps in the following locations:

- a) Stanley Street, Nelson, from its roundabout junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 6 metres in a north westerly direction;
- b) Manchester Road, Nelson, north east bound carriageway, from a point 6.9 metres north east of its roundabout junction with Stanley Street for a distance of 6 metres in a north easterly direction;
- c) Manchester Road, Nelson, south west bound carriageway, from a point 6.6 metres north east of its roundabout junction with Broadway for a distance of 6 metres in a north easterly direction;
- d) Macleod Street, Nelson, from its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 4 metres in a north westerly direction;
- e) Mosley Street, Nelson, from a point 1.8 metres north west of its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 6 metres in a north westerly direction;
- f) Albert Street, Nelson, from a point 1.5 metres north west of its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 6 metres in a north westerly direction.

The road humps will have a maximum height not exceeding 100mm.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson. The proposals include road humps to reduce vehicle speeds and improve road safety particularly for pedestrians and vulnerable road users.
