

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BROADWAY AND MANCHESTER ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE
BOROUGH) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- 1) Introduce a signal controlled parallel crossing in Manchester Road, from a point 17.1 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Rigby Street for a distance of 44 metres on the south west bound carriageway and 34.6 metres on the north east bound carriageway in a north easterly direction.
- 2) Introduce a Toucan Crossing, in Manchester Road, from a point 28 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Macleod Street for a distance of 30.7 metres on the south west bound carriageway and 18 metres on the north east bound carriageway in a north easterly direction.
- 3) Introduce a Toucan Crossing, in Broadway, from its roundabout junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 32.6 metres in a south easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson. The proposals include pedestrian crossings to improve safety, support active travel and provide a convenient and accessible crossing points for pedestrians and cyclists.
