

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(MANCHESTER ROAD, NELSON, PENDLE BOROUGH)
(BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) To Remove a bus stop clearway in Manchester Road, Nelson, the north west side, from a point 4.2 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Mosley Street for a distance of 17 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 2) To introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Manchester Road, Nelson, the south east side, from a point 13.5 metres north east of its roundabout junction with Broadway for a distance of 42.9 metres in a north easterly direction;
 - b) Manchester Road, Nelson, the north west side, from a point 18.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Albert Street for a distance of 7.1 metres in a south westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson. The proposals include Bus Stop Clearways to prioritise bus services and encourage the use of public transport.
