

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 Lancashire County Council propose the following

- 1) To convert the following lengths of footway to joint use cycleways:
 - a) Mosley Street, south west side, from its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 7.6 metres in a north westerly direction;
 - b) Manchester Road, north west side, from a point 3.7 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Mosley Street for a distance of 22.5 metres in a south westerly direction;
 - c) Manchester Road, south east side, from a point 22 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Rigby Street for a distance of 31.4 metres in a south westerly direction;
 - d) Manchester Road, north west side, from a point 9.5 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Stanley Street for a distance of 11 metres in a north easterly direction;
 - e) Manchester Road, all sides, on the section of highway located between a point 3.2 metres and 11.6 metres north east of its roundabout junction with Stanley St/Broadway, 4.5 metres south of its junction with Stanley Street and 9.5m north of its junction with Broadway;
 - f) Manchester Road, south east side, from a point 2 metres north east of its roundabout junction with Broadway for a distance of 17 metres in a north easterly direction;
 - g) Broadway, south west side, from a point 13.7 metres south east of its roundabout junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 9.6 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - h) Broadway, south side, from its junction with the centreline of Broad Street for a distance of 16.8 metres in a westerly direction;
 - i) Broadway, north and north east side, from a point 24.8 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Broad Street to its roundabout junction with Manchester Road;
 - j) Broad Street, west side, from its junction with Broadway for a distance of 8 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2) To convert the following lengths of footway to bi-directional segregated cycle:
 - a) Manchester Road, south east side, from a point 17.8 metres south west of its junction with Rigby Street to its roundabout junction with Broadway;
 - b) Broadway, south west side, from its roundabout junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 13.7 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - c) Broadway, south side, from a point 23.3 metres south east of its roundabout junction with Manchester Road to a point 13.5 metres west of its junction with Broad Street;
 - d) Manchester Road, north west side, from a point 5 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Albert Street to a point 9.5 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Stanley Street.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this scheme is to support the improved amenity in Nelson Town Centre, with improved pedestrian and cycle access and linkage across Nelson. All the proposals will work together to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and vulnerable users. It is hoped this will give confidence to encourage more users to consider commuting via non-motorised means and this will improve health and air quality for the residents of Nelson.

The proposals include shared and segregated cycleway / footway to provide a safe, accessible, and inclusive route for both cyclist and pedestrians, encouraging active travel while minimising conflict between users.
