(MALTKILN LANE, BISPHAM, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Maltkiln Lane, Bispham from its junction with Back Lane for a distance of 335 metres in a northerly direction Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 to 1500 hours on Tuesday 24th February 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
Access for emergency services will be always maintained.
3. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Chorley Road, B5246 Robin Lane, B5246 Hall Lane, B5246 Rufford Road, Black Moor Road, Smithy Lane, High Street, Jay Bank

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation clearance works to be carried out around overhead electrical cables.
