(HOSCAR MOSS ROAD, LATHOM, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hoscar Moss Road, Lathom for a distance of 20 metres either side of Hoscar Lane level crossing.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0020 to 0530 hours on Wednesday 8th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Hoscar Moss Road, Waness Blades Road, Mains Lane, B5246 Hall Lane, B5246 Robin Lane, B5246 Chorley Road, B5246 Lancaster Lane, A5209 Alder Lane, A5209 Ash Brow, A5209 Course Lane, A5209 Lowry Hill Lane, A5209 Briars Lane, Ring O'Bells Lane, Hoscar Moss Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing annual service works to be carried out.
