
(TOWER HILL ROAD, UP HOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Tower Hill Road, Up Holland from outside 108 Tower Hill Road to outside the side of 9 Hereford Grove.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 7th April 2026 until 1700 hours on Thursday 9th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Due to the nature of the works, there will be no access for emergency services.**
4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Tower Hill Road, A577 Ormskirk Road, Chequer Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out.
