(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

(TEMPORARY AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026

The Lancashire County Council (“the County Council”) in exercise of its powers under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, (the Act), and of all other enabling powers, **HEREBY** makes the following Order:-

The Lancashire County Council (BROOKE STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic) Order 2025, is hereby temporarily Amended in that:

- i. To amend Article 3 as follows:
 - i. 2300 hours on Saturday 31st January 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 1st February 2026
 - ii. 2300 hours on Saturday 7th February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 8th February 2026
 - iii. 2300 hours on Saturday 28th February 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 1st March 2026
 - iv. 2300 hours on Saturday 11th April 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 12th April 2026.
 - v. 2300 hours on Saturday 18th April 2026 until 0700 hours on Sunday 19th April 2026.

This Temporary Amendment Order shall come into operation on Friday 13th February 2026 and may be cited as “**The Lancashire County Council (BROOKE STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic) Order 2025 (Temporary Amendment) Order 2026**”
