
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Kee Holme Lane, Borwick from its junction with the private entrance to property known as Starricks Farm to the private entrance to property known as Lake House.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1900 hours on Tuesday 3rd March 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Keer Holme Lane - Lancaster Brow - Docker Lane – B6254 Kirkby Lonsdale Road – Borwick Road – Keer Holme Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to facilitate vegetation clearance around overhead electrical cables.
