(TEMPORARY AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026

The Lancashire County Council (“the County Council”) in exercise of its powers under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, (the Act), and of all other enabling powers, **HEREBY** makes the following Order:-

The Lancashire County Council (Broadway to Bolton le Sands, Lancaster City Council) (Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic) Order 2026, is hereby temporarily Amended in that:


- i. To amend Article 1 as follows:

No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of every highway specified in column 2 in the schedule to this order

This Temporary Amendment Order shall come into operation on Tuesday 17th February 2026 and may be cited as “**The Lancashire County Council (Broadway to Bolton le Sands Scheme, Lancaster City Council) (Temporary Prohibition Of Through Traffic) Order 2026 (Temporary Amendment) Order 2026**”

Lansdowne Road, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East for a distance of 5 metres
Princess Crescent, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
Beach Street, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
Grange Street, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
Park Street, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
Seaborn Road, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
St Margarets Road, Morecambe	From its junction with Marine Road East East for a distance of 5 metres
