

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BACK LANE, CHARNOCK RICHARD, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Charnock Richard from a point 830 metres west of its junction with A49 Preston Road, Charnock Richard for a distance of 492 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Tuesday 5th May 2026 until 1630 hours on Wednesday 6th May 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Back Lane – A49 Preston Road – Mill Lane – Park Hall Road - B5250 Wood Lane - B5250 Langton Brow - B5250 The Green – Bradley Lane – Red Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telecom pole maintenance works to be carried out.
